At the last FMCA Rally in Gillette, the Long-Range Planning committee presented the following information. The key conclusions from the survey data: Most RVers own towables – FMCA must emphasize towables over motorhomes. Most RVers do not travel far from home and do not use their RV more than 30 days a year. The FMCA emblem does not relate to typical RV owners. The FMCA name and reference to "motor coach" is a hindrance to growth, but emphasis on "family" is positive.

Discounts and roadside assistance are key benefits desired. RV chapters and medical evacuation program are not incentives to stimulate membership growth. Hanging out with friends and meeting new people is what RVing is all about.

Long-Range Planning Committee Chairman Jerry Ayres called on committee member Al Zimmerman to give a Power Point presentation developed by the committee. Al recognized the committee members as follows: Jerry Ayres, Chairman; Joanne Fadale; Vanessa Simmons; and Fred Terranova. He noted the dedication and time committed by each member with their weekly workshops.

Al shared that the committee's work really started in the fall of 2021. The committee reviewed the implications of the 2020 RVIA study data. Al reported that FMCA is not a significant player among RV owners (.69%) or even motorhome owners (3.3%.) They indicate that FMCA must shift its appeal to those who do not travel far from home and use their RV primarily in the summer. FMCA must respond to those who use their RV less than 30 days a year (69%.) FMCA must emphasize towables, which is 56% of RV owners, as much or more than motorhome owners. FMCA's leadership must reflect the target market, while retaining the best of its current structure.

For planning purposes, they identified four target markets, noting that the primary target market is RV owners who are age 55-65, empty nesters, recently retired or retired, and relatively affluent but not wealthy. The younger RV owners are active, using their RVs for an active lifestyle, such as hobbies and sports. Other markets we need to think about are vendors, parts, campgrounds, etc.

The bottom line is that FMCA needs to change in order to survive and continue flourishing. Maybe the same has to happen with the Beavers?



Ingredients

It can provide family travel expense, plus return of the RV, family members, pets and passenger automobiles. This amazing benefit is included in your FMCA membership at no extra cost.

2)FMCA tire savings program provides major discounts for all your vehicles to include the following tires: Michelin, U.S. and Canada, B. F. Goodrich, Uniroyal and Goodyear. Continental Tires are only for trucks and RVs.

3)Group rate on FMCA Roadside Rescue – this includes towing, fuel delivery, lockout service, battery boost, technical assistance, and more. The Roadside Rescue policy covers additional family members living in your household, and additional passenger vehicles.

4) Great rates on RV insurance. For more information and to get a quote at no cost, visit www.fmcarvinsurance.com, or call 877-589-3599.

5) Publication of the monthly FMCA magazine, which features technical and do-it-yourself information for RV owners, as well as campgrounds, and new RV models. The magazine tells about upcoming FMCA international conventions, as well as smaller rallies.

6)Colorful travelogues on RV destinations are featured monthly – from large national parks to out-ofthe-way towns and byways you may want to explore. 7)FMCA advocates nationwide on behalf of RV owner interests on issues that affect all of us. 8) Members only have access to the FMCA RV Mar8)Members only have access to the FMCA RV Marketplace, which is a fast, easy way to find FMCA commercial members who offer parts and services members might need.

RV's medicine cabinent makeover tips

Begin by removing everything from the medicine cabinet. Then inspect each box, bottle, and jar of medications, checking for expiration dates. Once the expired items are gone, sort everything that's left, placing similar-use items together. For example, beauty products in one group, grooming tools in another, and first aid in yet another. Then comes the hard part. For each beauty product, ask yourself: When did I last use this? If you can't remember, or if it was more than a year ago, toss it into a zipper-type bag or the trash. Items inside the zipper bag will be donated, if possible, or simply store them in your sticks-and-bricks home.

The next step is finding ways to consolidate like items as much as possible. For example, different boxes of Band-Aids. Although the plastic bandage strips were of various sizes, fit them all into a single box. Put duplicate products in a bag to be taken out of the RV.

Next up? A trip to the dollar store to find clear plastic containers to hold the medicine cabinet's remaining items, taking the medicine cabinet measurements along. Now you can easily see what's inside each container and the plastic will hold up to any bumpy roads.

The Finance Committee has been working on several projects since October 1st.

- To make financial reporting more robust, the data has been converted from Quicken on the MAC to Quickbooks on a Windows PC. (Thank you so much to Paul Meehan who was able to get the BAC an HP Windows computer at no cost!!) This move also saves the subscription costs that were needed to support Quicken. A final solution for the data is under review, but there is currently no cost for Quickbooks software.
- A preliminary 2024 budget is under development and review and will be submitted to the committee by the end of January.
- The Wells Fargo Advisor's Account has been closed and the funds have been deposited in the Wells Fargo Checking Account. The committee will be reviewing alternatives for those funds that can provide a better return to the BAC.
- Zelle has been adopted as the preferred method for payment to members for refunds, rally distributions to rally masters, and other items that were handled with checks in the past. Checks are still available, but this method allows immediate access to the funds without the need to wait till a check arrives in the mail. I will always contact you to determine your preferred method of payment.

The winter season has descended upon us!! On my way to Spokane for a business meeting in Las Vegas, I saw some things I'd never seen before. I left my little front-wheel drive car at home and borrowed my husband's 4-wheel drive truck for the trip. Thank God for 4-wheel drive and exhaust brakes! - 3. Click on "Register" for the rally you would like to attend.
- 4. Complete the registration form as instructed.
- 5. Submit rally payment using the link provided.
- 6. If registering as a single occupant, click on that option and pay the appropriate amount (if available).
- 7. Review and update your profile (https://www.beaveramb.org/Sys/Profile) to ensure that all "Information required for Rally Participation" is completed. This information is retained so you will not need to re-enter it for future rallies
- 8. All rally payments must be submitted online within 72 hours or your registration may be cancelled by the Rally Master.

Once the payment is submitted you will receive a confirmation that your registration is complete. As always, please do not hesitate to contact me directly if any questions or if I can help with your registration.
